


Christ knew The PLAN

Annual Holydays Harvests Pattern



NOTE: The “Harvests Pattern” and the above symmetry support the interpretation that the Passover is on the first day of the seven days of unleavened bread. The Spring and Fall “Harvests” are separated by Holydays 4 and 5. The Spring Harvest deals with the Church. The Fall Harvest deals with the World. Two training (planting) periods precede each harvest. Holyday 2 is the “sign” to awaken the End-Time Church to the Spring Harvest.

Jesus Christ knew that the Seven Annual Holydays commanded in Leviticus 23 depicted seven critical sequential events in God's PLAN for mankind.

49 “I have come to cast fire upon the earth [Holyday 4 Trumpets]; and how I wish it were already kindled!

50 But I have a baptism to undergo [Holyday 1 Passover], and how distressed I am until it is accomplished!

These two verses show that Christ knew that Holyday 1, Passover, had to be fulfilled before Holyday 4, the Feast of Trumpets.

This means that Christ knew that the HOLYDAYS constituted a sequential PLAN for the salvation of mankind!

Christ knew that these Seven Holydays constituted His Father's WILL for mankind and that His death was the extremely critical first step in that PLAN.

Therefore, Christ must have know that He would also have to fulfill the next six Holydays in the PLAN.

In fact, the parable about the Bridegroom shows that Christ knew that He would be fulfilling Holyday 3, Pentecost, by marrying His Bride, the church, before His return to earth on Holyday 4, the Feast of Trumpets, to save mankind from total self-annihilation.

So it's logical to assume that Christ also knew that He would have to transform the desert into a sanctuary for His Bride in order to fulfill Holyday 2, the Last Day of Unleavened Bread, so that the Bride could gather together and be separated from the world to become the "kingdom of priests" and "holy nation" that Christ prophesied would exist on earth before His return.

In fact, Christ knew that these first three Holydays constituted the Spring Harvest phase of God's PLAN by only citing these three Holydays and leaving out Holyday 4 as His mission on earth when He quoted Isaiah 61:1-2. Christ was focused on the gospel (good news) of this Spring Kingdom that would exist on earth before the End.

Now that Holyday 1 is accomplished, Christ is focused on fulfilling Holydays 2 and 3 to bring about the Spring Kingdom on earth.

When the Holyday 2 Miracle occurs, then the Bride will also recognize The PLAN.
